<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Teaching Sequence Suggestions</b></p>	<p>12.2.1 – Explain the learning targets and aim of the lesson.  12.2.2 – Direct instruction on the Art and Ideas of the Renaissance.  12.2.3 – Students will follow along taking Cornell Notes.  12.2.4 – Students will compare Medieval Art to Renaissance Art and list the key differences.  12.2.5 – Students will complete a graphic organizer on selected artists of the Renaissance to prepare for a future <i>Renaissance Artist Quilt Activity</i>.  12.2.6 – Students will read Art and Literature 1 to build reading comprehension skills.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Text Set Selections:</b></p>	<p>Students will read <i>Art and Literature 1</i> to build 'whole of the text' reading comprehension skills. (Remedial activity) on the Ideas and Art of the Renaissance, identify the key artists, and complete a graphic organizer assignment.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Background Concerns</b></p>	<p>Students will use their laptop computer to gather research about artists of the Renaissance, their style of painting or sculptures, and provide examples and descriptions of their masterpieces. Instructor will recommend various web sites for students to research Renaissance artists.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Text Talk:</b></p>	<p>Students will read, analyze, and complete a graphic organizer on selected artists of the Renaissance.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Task Response:</b></p>	<p>Students will use the SQ3R strategy to read the Ideas and Art of the Renaissance, utilize the Post-It-Note organization of information strategy, and transcribe the information gathered onto a graphic organizer that features selected artists and their masterpieces</p>
