<p><b>Learning Targets and Intentions of the Lesson</b></p>	<p><b><i>I Want Students to:</i></b>  <b>1. Know</b> the significance of the contributions of Renaissance artists to European Society. <b>2. Understand</b> structure in place that enabled Renaissance Artists to increase the awareness of nature, the revival of classical learning, and a more individualistic view of man. <b>3. Construct (<i>Skill</i>)</b> a Renaissance Quilt on a selected Renaissance artist.</p>
<p><b>Teaching Sequence Suggestions</b></p>	<p>12.1-2.1 – Students will use their devices to gather information on their assigned artist; 20-minute time limit.  12.1-2.2 – Students will follow the template of their rubric to organize their data collection.  12.1-2.3 – Instructor will provide URLs to selected websites to maximize efficiency in student search time.  12.1-2.4 – Instruct will direct students to begin constructing their Renaissance Quilts; 60-minute time limit.  12.1-2.5 – Instructor will circulate around the classroom insuring students are on task, on target, and aware of time constraints.  12.1-2.5 – Instructor will insure accommodations adhered to for EC (Exceptional Children), EB (Emergent Bilingual), and any other struggling students.  12.1-2.6 - Students complete their project as homework.</p>
