<p>Learning Targets and Intentions of the Lesson</p>	<p>I Want Students to: 1. KNOW the political, social, and religious relationship of the Scientific Revolution to the Enlightenment. 2. UNDERSTAND and explain the impact of contributions made by enlightenment leaders to the Scientific Revolution. 3. Analyze readings (SKILL) and define the relationships between the government and the state of nature and the government and the people.</p>
<p>Scope and Sequence of the Lesson</p>	<p>17.2.1 – Explain the learning targets and aim of the lesson. 17.2.2 – Direct instruction on the Enlightenment. 17.2.3 – Students will take Guided Notes to build a knowledge base on the ideals of the Enlightenment. 17.2.4 – Students will read the Enlightenment reading <i>Why Government</i> and complete the various skill building activities. 17.2.5 – Upon completion of the reading students will respond to selected questions and complete the various skill building activities. 17.2.6 Students will analyze instructor selected primary documents and respond to the questions asked at the end of each document. Honors – Students will format their three references onto their research paper and begin drafting the “Abstract.”</p>
<p>Text Set Selections:</p>	<p>Students will read, analyze, examine, and evaluate primary documents.</p>
<p>Background Concerns</p>	<p>Instructor needs to preface the Enlightenment so that students understand the significance of Enlightenment ideals and innovations that shaped the world we know today.</p>

Text Analysis	Students will use the SQ3R reading strategy to comprehend the primary and secondary documents contained in the <i>Enlightenment</i> reading activity. Students will complete the questions asked by each of the primary documents.
Text Talk	Students will read, analyze, synthesize, evaluate, and answer questions on primary and secondary documents to build their critical thinking skills.
