<p align="center">Scope and Sequence of the Lesson</p>	<p>1.3.1 – Explain the learning targets and aim of the lesson.</p> <p>1.3.2 – Instructor will begin a class discussion: How does geography influence where you live and how does it determine the interaction with your neighbors?</p> <p>1.3.3 - Students will follow direct instruction taking guided notes on Early Civilizations and the Geography of Greece.</p> <p>1.3.4 – Students will use their Cornell notes to complete a Geography of Greece activity.</p> <p>1.3.5 – Students will compare the Minoans and the Mycenaean and complete a Venn Diagram comparing both civilizations.</p>
