<p><b>Do Now</b></p>	<p>What does the word reform mean? What does reform mean in relation to the church?</p>
<p>The Learning Intentions in terms of <b>Knowledge, Understanding, and Skills</b></p>	<p><b>I Want Students To:</b> 1. <b>Know</b> the significance of Martin Luther’s new doctrine of salvation that resulted in a break from the Catholic church and the establishment of Lutheranism. 2. <b>Understand</b> the way humanism and Erasmus forged the Reformation. 3. Analyze (<b>Skill</b>) how Calvinism replaced Lutheranism as the most dynamic form of Protestantism.</p>
<p>Scope and Sequence of the Lesson</p>	<p>10.1-2.1 – Students will use their devices to gather information on their assigned artist; 20 minute time limit. 10.1-2.2 – Students will follow the template of their rubric to organize their data collection. 10.1-2.3 – Instructor will provide URLs to selected websites to maximize efficiency in student search time. 10.1-2.4 – Instruct will direct students to begin constructing their Renaissance Quilts; 60-minute time limit. 10.1-2.5 – Instructor will circulate around the classroom insuring students are on task, on target, and aware of time constraints. 10.1-2.5 – Instructor will insure accommodations are adhered to for EC (Exceptional Children), EB (Emergent Bilingual), and any other struggling students. 10.1-2.6 - Students will be allowed to complete their project as homework. Due at the start of class Tuesday.</p>
