<p style="text-align: center;">Scope and Sequence of the Lesson</p>	<p>1.3.1 – Explain the learning targets and aim of the lesson. 1.3.2 – Instructor will begin a class discussion: Where would you like to start a civilization and what are three things that you must have? 1.3.3 - Students will follow direct instruction taking guided notes on River Valley civilizations. 1.3.4 – Students will use their guided notes to complete a Four-Civilization PERSIAN Chart. 1.3.5 – Students will take any two civilizations and complete a Venn Diagram comparing both civilizations.</p>
