

**Make Your Plan to Vote: Election 2020**

**\*No ID Required to Vote in 2020**

**\*Questions: Call 828-250-4200**

**1. Is your Voter Registration Current?**

You must be registered to vote at your current address at least 25 days before Election Day- **the deadline is 10/9/2020 (unless you register at Early Voting)**. Check your voter registration status online at: [NC Voter Search Tool](#)

See your current address, your current party affiliation, your voting districts, your precinct number and polling place location, and download your **Sample Ballot**

**2. Do you need to Register to Vote or Update your Registration? (3 ways)**

a. **Register to vote online at the DMV** (must have current NC ID to use this method) at:

**3. Make a Plan for Voting- There are 3 Ways to Vote in North Carolina**

a. **Vote by Mail** (Absentee Ballot)- Anyone can vote by mail in NC.

c. **Vote at your Precinct on Election Day, November 3, 2020. Polls open 6:30 a.m.-7:30 p.m.**

**Please vote at your assigned precinct on Nov. 3.**
